Carmen Motellón García holds a degree in Civil Engineering (Ingeniero de Caminos, Canales y Puertos) from the Technical University of Madrid. She also holds a Master in Business Administration from Instituto de Empresa and is a Senior Civil Servant of the Spanish State, in the Information Technologies branch.

In 1995, she joined the Deputy Directorate-General of the Treasury, where she held several positions. After a period as Head of the Accounting Service of the Community of Madrid, she joined the Directorate-General of the Treasury and Financial Policy as Deputy Director-General for State Receipts and Payments. In 2008, she was appointed Coordinating Advisor for Guarantees in the Office of the Minister of Economy and Finance. In 2010, she was appointed Chief Financial Officer of the National Union of Credit Cooperatives (UNACC) and subsequently held the position of Director of Shareholder Services and Institutional Relations at Banco de Crédito Social Cooperativo of the Cajamar Group. She has served as an advisory member of the Consultative Committee of the National Securities Market Commission (CNMV), as a member of the Board of Directors of Minas de Almadén y Arrayanes, S.A., and of the Royal Mint of Spain (Fábrica Nacional de Moneda y Timbre), as well as an advisory member of the Executive Committee of that Board of Directors.

She has also served as Board Member, Chair of the Audit Committee, and Chair of the Appointments and Remuneration Committee of SAREB, and as Board Member of the IMF Group.

She is currently a member of the Board of Directors of CECABANK, where she chairs the Audit Committee and is a member of the Risk Committee. Since June 2022, she has also been a member of the Board of Directors of Mercedes-Benz Financial Services España (EFC), serving on its Joint Audit and Risk Committee and on its Appointments and Remuneration Committee.
